Invoices:

School fees cover tuition and are invoiced termly, payable in advance¹.

Payment can be made by one of these means:

- **termly**, paid on the first day of each term.
- **monthly**, paid in twelve (12) instalments by direct debit in advance starting from 20th August and continuing on 20th (or 25th) of each month.
- **annually**, paid as a single payment at the start of each academic year.

When new pupils start in the Primary school, or in some Secondary year groups, during an academic year, fees will fall due on or before the pupil's start date as arranged with the Bursar.

Payments:

The King's School Parent Contract provides for the school fee payment by Direct Debit, termly or monthly.

Payments are due 'in advance' on the 20th monthly commencing 20th August annually.

Direct Debit will save you time. The link for online registration for direct debit payments is as follows:

After you input your account payment details, a direct debit mandate will be provided by return. Payments will be taken automatically as invoiced, each time they are due. For your peace of mind, you are fully protected by the Direct Debit Guarantee.

Please note that if a parent or guardian chooses to withdraw their child or children, the School requires notice of a full school term. The notice should be addressed to the Headteacher in writing.

If a term's notice cannot be given the fees for the term will still be due.

¹ *in advance, that is, School Fees paid in advance – Under Financial Conduct Authority FCA (formerly FSA) regulations, The King's School is not permitted to issue credit. It may however take payments in no more than four (4) instalments over a quarter/four-month period, **only if payments are made in advance** of the service being offered. Hence this School's stipulation is 12 payments on the 20th monthly.
